

Marriage License

The DCC (Masjid Al-Salam) performs Islamic marriage (Nikah) at its Center.



Information and Instructions

1. Contact the DCC prior to Nikah date to schedule an appointment for Nikah with the Imam. Email at dearborncommunitycenter@gmail.com or call the Masjid Telephone: 313-584-9494. Leave your name, telephone number and date you wish to get marry.
2. The following individuals need to be present:
 - The groom and the bride
 - Two Muslim witnesses
 - A guardian (Wali) for the bride.
3. Bring the following documents to the appointment:
 - Original copy of the Michigan Marriage License (see below for information and locations for obtaining Michigan Marriage License).
 - Proper photo identification cards/passports with copies:
 - The groom and the bride

- The witnesses
- The guardian (if applicable)
- DCC Nikah Application Form

There is a \$300 fee which applies for a ceremony conducted in the Masjid, and a fee of \$300 which applies for ceremonies conducted elsewhere.

Michigan Marriage License

Marriage license is issued by a county court judge or clerk of the circuit court under his or her hand and seal. Marriage licenses are issued by counties and you can apply for your license at any county clerk's. Michigan Clerk office.

Shahada (Declaration of faith in Islam)



Shahada is the Muslim declaration of belief in the oneness of Allah (God) and acceptance of Muhammad as his prophet. Important notes:

- It is recommended that on this very special occasion to wash your entire body with the intention of embracing Islam.
- Please bring some form of identification (driver's license etc.) with you for verification purpose.

- Upon your arrival to the mosque, the Imam on duty asks questions to assure your full conviction, in addition he will also brief you with certain fundamental principles of Islam.
- New Muslims are encouraged to join a revert class or have someone to teach them throughout their journey. In doing so, new reverts can learn to pray and become more familiar with the principles of Islam. The purpose is for Muslims to gain support from each other and from others that have more experience in the faith.
